They use **Deadstock & Vintage fabrics**, repurposing leftover materials and old clothing into new designs, reducing waste and carbon emissions. Linen, made from the flax plant, is another sustainable choice, known for its minimal water use and durability. Recycled Cashmere & Recycled Wool are incorporated into their knitwear and outerwear, providing luxurious textures with a reduced environmental footprint. ECONYL® regenerated nylon is used in place of virgin nylon, repurposing waste from oceans and landfills.

By utilizing these sustainable materials, The Reformation not only creates fashionable, high-quality clothing but also significantly reduces their environmental impact, promoting responsible fashion choices.
